### MCA's 60<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of Mustang Show

Perfect weather, thousands of Mustangs and Southern Hospitality made the MCA's 60<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of Mustang celebration a success. This event was held in Birmingham, AL at the Barber Motorsports Park on April 5-7, 2024. Having attended the 35<sup>th</sup>, 40<sup>th</sup>, and 50<sup>th</sup> celebrations, Kami wanted to add this milestone to her list.

When we left Valparaiso on April 4<sup>th</sup>, snow flurries greeted us at the IL state line. Snow was short lived, but then there was rain for most of the trip down to AL.



The Birmingham Marriott was the host hotel and proved to be very accommodating to the many Mustangs and car trailers. The parking lot provided a great space to catch up with old friends and to meet new ones. The Barber Motorsports Park was 14 miles away, but it was easy access from the hotel, either by way of a scenic, twisty road or past a Buc-ee's via the interstate (both great options).

We don't know the total count of Mustangs for this 60<sup>th</sup>, but registration for judged classes was cut off at 400, and over 2,000+ cars were expected in the display class. There were also almost two hundred Mustangs participating in the racing on the track, and autocross was available for any registered show car. Kami drove her 2002 Roush convertible and entered in the Judged Roush Class. At the Sunday afternoon Awards Ceremony, Kami was proud to be awarded a GOLD.



We have been a proud Mustang family, almost since the beginning. My parents bought a 1968 Mustang new, which we still own today. This vehicle got Kami started with Mustangs, as she drove it to high school and college.

It was 1,500 miles round trip, and we enjoyed every mile (Kami mostly the Buc-ee's stops). We even got to experience driving home during the 4 minutes of total darkness from the eclipse in southern Illinois.
